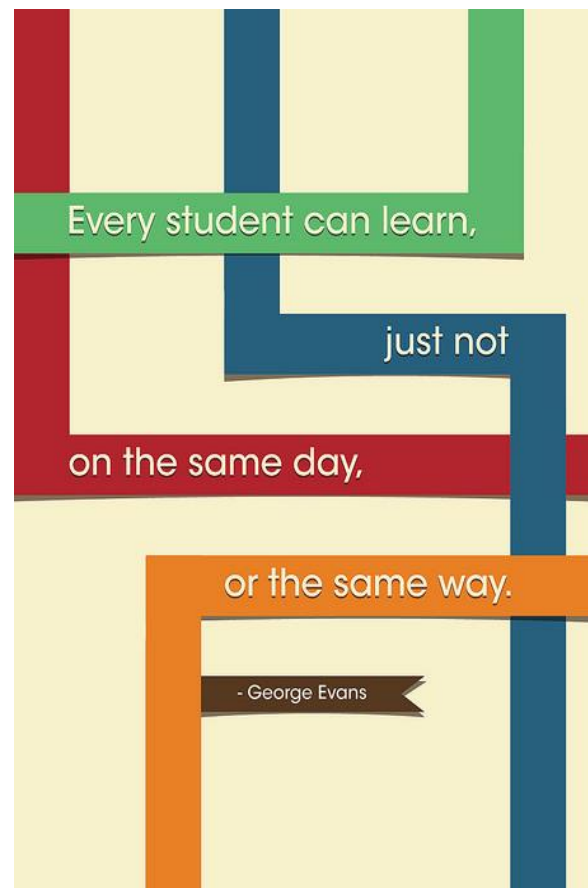
MyBlueprint is a tool that will help you monitor your progress through high school and help you plan for your future. It has many different functions all located in one convenient space.
