## Homestay Hosts Needed for International Students in Lethbridge

When we welcome international students into our schools, our programs benefit, our community benefits and local students get life-changing experiences that positively shape their world view. Without you, we can't deliver this exciting program. You can help by inviting international students to stay with your family while they study in Lethbridge. The greatest need is for short-term groups (2-weeks to 3-month stays). We are currently especially preparing to welcome a group who will attend four of our high schools from April 9-May 5, 2018.

To support our homestay families, we've partnered with the Canada Homestay Network (CHN), a not-for-profit, family-run, Canadian business that's been a leader in homestay since 1995. CHN provides cultural and first-language support to hosts 24x7 and an allowance of over \$700/month to help offset expenses.

### What you provide:

1. Three nutritious meals per day
2. Utilities including laundry and internet
3. A private bedroom, desk (or a nearby quiet study area) and closet
4. A patient, caring, and friendly home atmosphere
5. The same guidance and attention you would want for your loved ones travelling overseas!
