The scholarship is intended to assist and encourage Southern Alberta students in their pursuit of this goal.
Award Value: One award of \$3,000 * payment is made over 3 years and is dependent on applicant meeting yearly qualifications.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be a Canadian Citizen or permanent resident and an Alberta resident (applicant's parent's must have resided in Alberta between July 1, 2017 & June 30, 2018)
- Be a grade 12 student who will have completed the requirements to graduate from high school by June 30th, 2018
- Be enrolled full-time in a post-secondary program in Canada, pursuing a degree in Accounting, Commerce or Business Management
- Submit a completed application form to Woodman White & Associates no later than **July 1st, 2018**

Selection Criteria: One student will be selected from all applicants to receive the award. The selection will be based on a combination of the following:

- Combined average final mark of English 30-1 or 30-2 and Math 30-1 and Math 30-2 (Preference will be given to those completing 30-1 courses).
- Submission of an essay (250 words maximum) responding to the question "Why ethics, honesty and integrity are essential characteristic of an Accountant!".
- Completion of any BIT Financial Management Course/Projects or Practicums taken between grades 10 and 12

Attention Grade 11's & 12's

Alberta Education no longer mails out diploma exam results or diploma statements. All information will be available to students on the Alberta Education myPass system where you can view and print diploma exam result statements, order transcripts, as well as view and print detailed academic reports (DAR). If you have not already created your personal myPass account you can pick up information in the office to get started now.
