

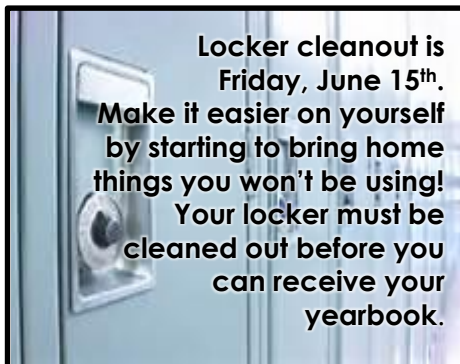

LIP DUB 2018!

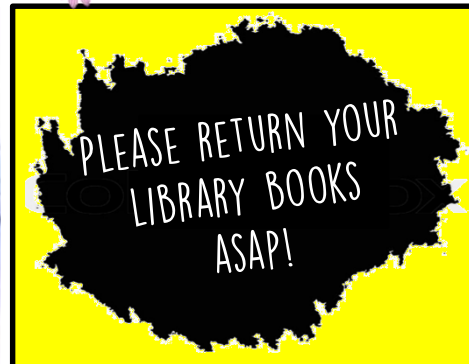
