




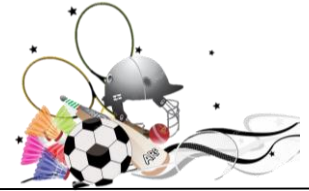

Off-Campus Education has an exciting summer opportunity for students interested in the trades.

The City of Lethbridge will be offering six Registered Apprenticeship Program positions for students this summer.

- 1 student to work in their plumbing department
- 1 student to work in their electrical department
- 2 students in their heavy equipment mechanic shop (fleet services)
- 1 student to work in their carpentry department

And possibly one student to work in their traffic light department

Fortis Alberta will place one Registered Apprenticeship Program student to work as a Power Line Technician this summer.
