FROM THE CAREER CENTRE

Schulich Leader Scholarships are Canada's most coveted undergraduate STEM scholarships. Fifty are awarded to entrepreneurial-minded high school graduates enrolling in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Math program at 20 partner universities across Canada. Twenty-five are valued at \$100,000 for engineering scholarships and 25 are valued at \$80,000* for science and math scholarships. Every high school in Canada can nominate one graduating student each year to apply for the scholarship, you must be nominated by your school. Apply before **Feb 2, 2019**. Off-Campus Education Experiential Career Learning Opportunity, March 14th & 15, 2019 - This event is an opportunity for students to explore the trade they have a strong interest and aptitude in as a career. There will be four groups of trades with multiple occupations for students to experience.

Automotive Group: Heavy Equipment Technician, Auto Body Technician, Auto Service Technician, Motorcycle mechanic, Recreation Vehicle Technician, Electrical Motor Technician.

Welding/Metal Fabrication Group: Welder, Sheet Metal Worker, Machinist.

Culinary Group: Cook, Baker.

Construction Group: Cabinet maker, Carpenter, Plumber, Electrician, Flooring Installer, Concrete Finisher
Students will be placed with an employer, in their career choice, for two days of unpaid on the job experiential learning. The students will be expected to have all the employer required PPE and responsible for their own transportation to and from the workplace.

The expectations of the students:

Punctuality, respect for all safety rules and employer guidelines, and participation in all employer planned activities. All students will be covered under the Lethbridge School District worker's compensation policy and must have their parent or guardians consent forms completed. There are a limited number of student placements available; students must have a genuine interest and commitment to the trade, and be working toward the required trade entrance requirements.

Heer Law Entrepreneurship Scholarship Criteria

In order to be eligible for the \$2000 CAD scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Must be currently attending university or college or set to attend during the 2018-2019 academic year;
2. Must be in good standing with their current or prospective institution;
3. Must apply via email and provide their name, address, university or college, major and expected graduation month and year;
4. Provide their application (a business plan for their current or prospective business which includes a section outlining intellectual property strategy) by December 31, 2018.

Applications will be judged on the strength of the business idea and the cogency of the business plan and intellectual property strategy. A winner will be chosen by January 31, 2019.

All submissions should be submitted via email to scholarship@heerlaw.com. All business plans submitted in application for this scholarship will be treated as strictly confidential.
