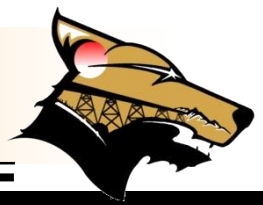
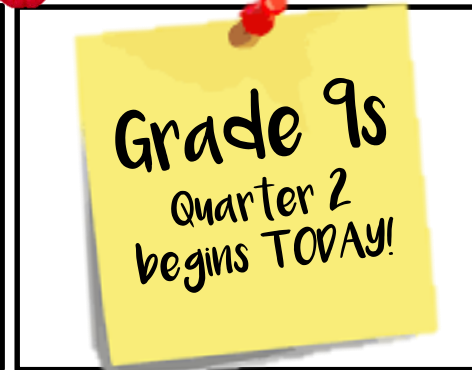

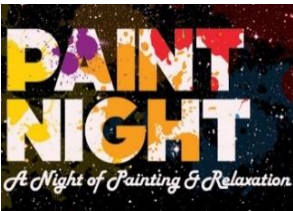
HAPPENING AT CHINOOK

LEARNING SESSION FOR PARENTS

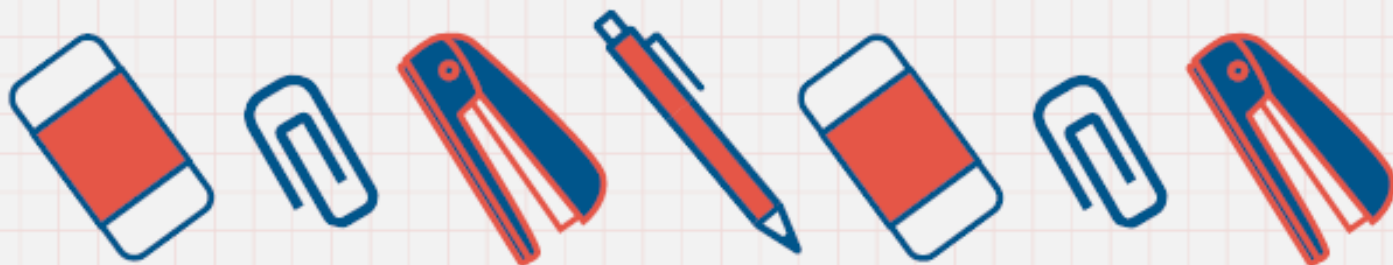
The parent information session will focus on technology, specifically the programs students have access to at school and at home.
