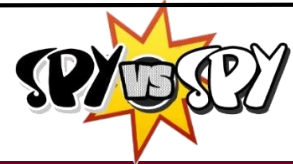
COMING UP

Loran Scholarship - Grade 12 students may apply now at www.apply.loranscholar.ca. The student needs to submit a transcript, request a reference from a teacher/community member and have their school sponsorship confirmed before the deadline. **School-sponsored**

Deadline: October 18, 2017. **Additional students may submit direct pool applications (without sponsorship) by October 25, 2017**

Horatio Alger Scholarship - The Horatio Jim Pattison Scholarship is awarded to full-time students (Canadian Citizens) in Alberta with financial need (\$55,000 or less net family income) who have demonstrated integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity, as well as strength of character, a good academic record (65% minimum), a commitment to pursue a post-secondary education, and a desire to contribute to society.
