**Horatio Alger Scholarship** – The Horatio Jim Pattison Scholarship is awarded to full-time students (Canadian Citizens) in Alberta with financial need (\$55,000 or less net family income) who have demonstrated integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity, as well as strength of character, a good academic record (65% minimum), a commitment to pursue a post-secondary education, and a desire to contribute to society.
