

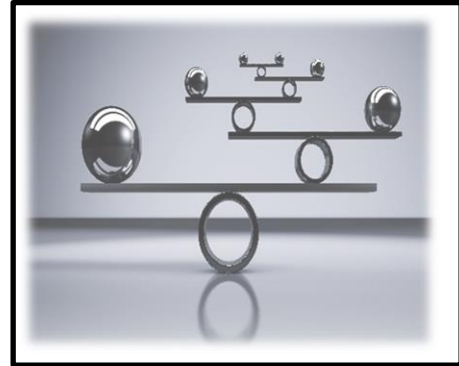

This program is currently offered to help an individual prepare for their Learner's (Class 7).
