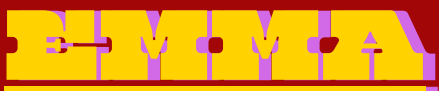

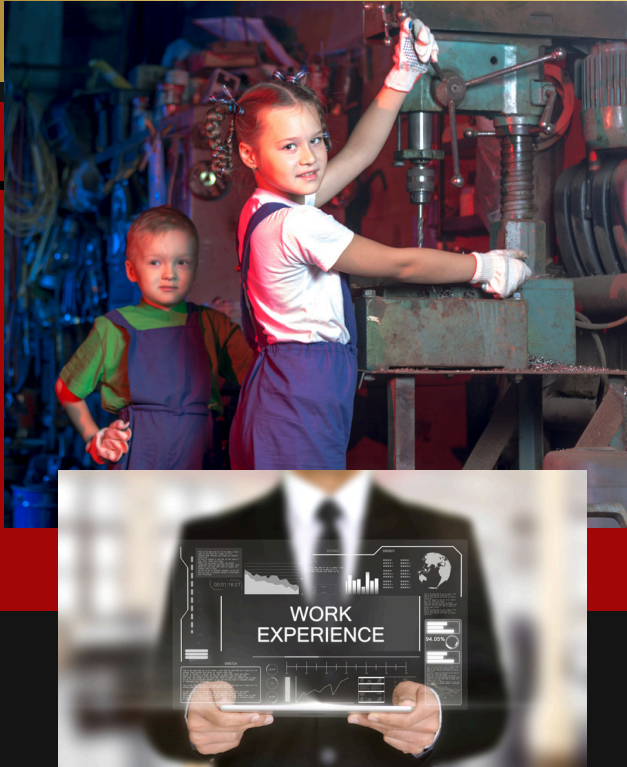

Work Experience



For students currently enrolled in work experience or the Registered Apprenticeship Program, you must submit all hours by June 15 for the 2023/24 school year.

If you would like to earn credits in work experience through a job or a volunteering opportunity this summer, you must have completed the required safety course (HCS3000) and have the work experience contract filled in and returned by June 15. One credit for every 25 hours of work, up to 15 credits towards your high school diploma. You must work/volunteer a minimum of 75 hours.
