Over the coming weeks you will notice a change in front of our building.

We are increasing accessibility at Chinook by removing barriers for families and students by creating a dedicated space that increases convenience for those with disabilities or mobility access needs.

We have 4 accessible buses that arrive at our building each morning & afternoon that will be utilizing what is currently a 15-minute parking zone. Soon, the City of Lethbridge will change signage indicating a larger no-parking zone nearest to the fire hydrant, east of the flagpoles. In the meantime, you will notice members of our Educational Assistant team kindly prompting drivers to create space for buses.
