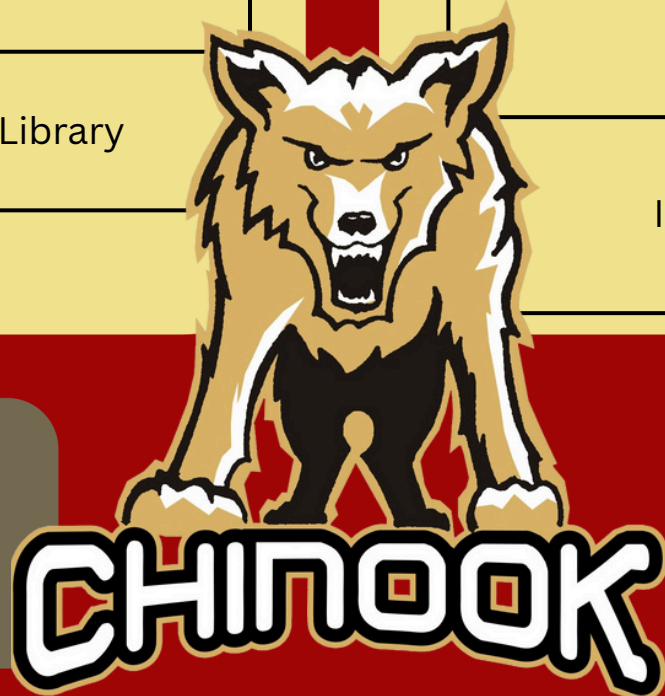

CLUB	BRIEF DESCRIPTION
CHINOOK CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP	We are a small group that meets during flex for a devotional and time of prayer. All are welcome!
ENVIRONMENT CLUB	Environment club explores some of the ways students can engage with our local environment. Students take the lead in planning activities for the club, as well as the whole school. We look forward to seeing you at our next meeting!
DRUMLINE	A musical group of percussion instruments that practice/perform songs and cadences. Students will learn how to improve their Rudiments, Chops and Drumming skills.
DICE GOBLINS (D&D)	The Dice Goblins is a student lead club that explores Tabletop Role Playing Games including Dungeons and Dragons.
GRAD COMMITTEE	Grad Committe is for all grade 12s who are interested in planning their Grad Gala. The majority of decisions are made in this group including designing the grad hoodie, planning the program, food choices, etc.

LANGUAGE CLUB	The chinook language club aims to connect language learners, fostering cultural and linguistic exchange. It provides an engaging environment where members can improve their language skills, share learning strategies, and connect with others who share a love for languages. Through interactive activities such as language games, guest speaker sessions, and language exchanges, members can enhance their learning in a fun and supportive way. Whether someone is learning a new language or looking to maintain their fluency, this club offers a space to practice, grow, and build confidence in their abilities.
CHINOOK CONCERT BAND	The Wind Ensemble at Chinook meets twice a week during Flex time throughout the year, earning 5 credits. This senior-level band rehearses during Flex and also holds an additional practice once a month after school. While there is no formal prerequisite for High School Band, students should be able to perform at a minimum Grade 3 (concert band level) on their instrument to succeed with the class repertoire. In this class, students will focus on scales, chords, tuning techniques, and enjoy playing a variety of pieces from the Concert Band repertoire. If you are interested but unsure of your skill level, please speak with the instructor for guidance on how to proceed. For students eager to expand their band experience, we also offer an after-school Jazz Band, providing additional opportunities to develop your skills and earn high school credits.
COSPLAY/FANDOM CLUB	A student run club that includes, cosplay, anime, manga, fandoms, and anything geeky or needy. We take part in Halloweek and go to Calgary Expo in April. All are welcome.
